2010 League Fee Schedule Pinto thru Pony Division

2010 League fees for teams in the Pinto thru Pony Division will be \$1500.00 per team*

Method of Payments

Each team will determine how their team fee is collected. Options to consider
Could be, but not limited to (do whatever works best for your team):

- a. Players divide the entire fee and pay as individuals
Sponsor pays \$0.00, players pay \$125.00
- b. Partial sponsor buyout & players divide the remaining balance
Sponsor pays \$300.00 and each player pays \$100.00
- c. Total sponsor buyout
Sponsor pays \$1500.00 and each player pays \$0.00

*Team fees are based on a minimum of 12 players on a team. Add \$125.00 per additional player beyond the 12 minimum.

Candy Fundraiser

The candy fundraiser will be available.

A \$5.00 League Fee will need to be added to the candy money.

Each player who chooses to use the candy fundraiser will need to sell 4 (FOUR) boxes of candy.
(Each box of candy sells for \$60.00 with \$30.00 pays for candy and \$30.00 being applied to fees.)

A player using the fundraiser will have two weeks to sell his candy and then turn in \$240.00 at the end of the two weeks along with the \$5.00 for league fee. (\$240.00 to turn in to the HPBA office, \$120.00 to cover the fees and \$120.00 to cover the cost of the candy)

Volunteer Incentives

Teams can use Volunteer Incentives to eliminate up to \$200.00 of their team fee.

The Volunteer Incentive credit can be applied to a team's balance or refund to the team at the beginning of the baseball season once all other fees have been paid.

Volunteer Incentives

1. **Early League Membership** - \$100.00 credit **if \$300.00 is paid before 01/31/10**
2. **Workday Participation**** - \$100.00 credit for 10 team hours or more of work.
3. **Multiple Player Discount** – A family with more than one child playing at HPBA will receive a \$25.00 credit for the second and each subsequent child from their family who must pay fees.
Players who play for teams who are 100% paid for by sponsors and Rookie players do not count towards the multiple player discount number.

**Workday Participation hours must be recorded and signed by a league representative in order to receive credit. This incentive does not replace the non-participation penalty described in the league rules. Teams are still required to volunteer a designated amount of time each season to get the fields ready.

League Membership

League Membership – Teams will not be considered members of HPBA until a Minimum of \$300.00 has been paid toward team fees. Teams who are not HPBA members will not be allowed to play games until this minimum has been paid.
