### **2010 League Fee Schedule Rookie Division**

2010 League fees for teams in the Rookie Division will be \$325.00 per team\*

#### **Method of Payments**

How a team raises the team fee will be determined by each individual team.

Options to consider could be, but not limited to:

- a. Players divide the entire fee and pay as individuals  
Sponsor pays \$0.00 and each player pays \$25.00
- b. Partial sponsor buyout & players divide the remaining balance  
Sponsor pays \$195.00 and each player pays \$10.00
- c. Total sponsor buyout  
Sponsor pays \$325.00, players pay \$0.00

\*Team fees are based on a minimum of 13 players on a team. Add \$25.00 per additional player beyond the 13 minimum.

#### **Candy Fundraiser**

The candy fundraiser will be available. Each player who chooses to use the candy fundraiser will need to sell 1(one) box of candy.

A rookie player using the fundraiser will have **two weeks** to sell his candy and then turn in \$60.00 at the end of the two weeks. The Breakdown is as follows: \$30.00 for their league fee and \$30.00 for the cost of the candy.

#### **Volunteer Incentives**

Because the per player portion of the team fees are relatively small, there are no volunteer incentives for Rookie Teams.

#### **Uniform Incentives**

**HPBA will no longer provide catcher equipment.** Each team must provide their own catcher equipment. Helmets may be provided if HPBA can get them donated by Dick's Sporting Goods or by another source.

Teams who choose to obtain uniform shirts or uniform hats from a source other than HPBA can deduct \$5 per shirt and \$5 per hat from their team fee.

#### **League Membership**

– Teams who register as Rookie teams with HPBA will be considered members of HPBA when the team designates a coach. Rookie teams who are not HPBA members will not be allowed to play games until a coach has been named. Neither HPBA or HPBA liability insurance policies, assumes any liability for non-HPBA teams who choose to engage in activity prior to becoming members of HPBA.
